

### **IMPORTANT MISSION INFORMATION AND APPLICATION**

We are excited that you will be joining Sowing Seeds in Belize! The below important information will make your time in Belize more efficient and effective and prepare you for an amazing experience. Please read over carefully as there are many details to consider. You may click on items highlighted in blue below for more information related to that topic. We welcome individuals without a team to join us - we will schedule several trips each year where you will be able to join others to form a team with a minimum of 3 persons, maximum of 10. Those trips will be posted on our website on or before January 31<sup>st</sup> annually. <u>Costs and payment terms are detailed in the attached schedule of fees.</u>

### FLIGHT AND TRAVEL OPTIONS

Several US international airports offer flights to Belize. Consider using <u>City Express Travel</u>. They are a Christian travel agency specializing in booking group airfare for churches and mission trips. Ask for Simeon Kumar. Or refer to your airline or travel agency of choice for specific flight details and to book your flights. All flights arrive in Belize City at Philip S.W. Goldson International Airport (PGIA), 3-1/2 hours north of our location in the Toledo District. There two (2) options to consider for getting you and your team south to our mission location, each with different fees associated. <u>Refer to attached schedule of fees for more details</u>.

### **OPTION 1** – GROUND TRAVEL

A SSIB representative will be at the airport when you arrive and will transport you south. SSIB will also return you to PGIA for your flight home.

### **OPTION 2** – CONNECTING FLIGHT TO PUNTA GORDA AIRPORT

A connecting hopper flight from Belize City is available which flies directly into the Toledo District arriving at the Punta Gorda airport. Flights are available via <u>Maya Island Air</u> or <u>Tropic Air</u>. Click on links for flight costs and booking information.

Ground transportation will be made available to and from your choice of lodging location. <u>Refer to</u> <u>attached schedule of fees for more details.</u>

### **CUSTOMS DECLARATION FORM**

All travelers to Belize are required to fill out a customs declaration form on the plane before arrival in Belize. At the bottom of the form there will be two (2) questions which must be answered. Recommended answers are as follows:

### **IN-COUNTRY TRANSPORTATION DURING STAY**

The SSIB 15 passenger van is available for rental at \$500/week plus fuel (this is ½ of the cost of a local rental).

We highly suggest (however not required) staying at the Pallotine Retreat Center (PRC). Rooms have two single beds in a dorm style arrangement. Separate wings with community bathrooms for male/female are available.

There is a large conference room and a cozy gathering lounge with wi-fi and beautiful grounds to explore and enjoy. There is a short video of the rooms and grounds on our website. <u>Refer to attached schedule of fees for</u> <u>more details.</u>

If your group prefers to stay in a hotel, we can recommend several. Please contact us at <u>info@sowingseedsinbelize.com</u> for a list of recommended hotels in the area. If you choose the hotel option, you will be responsible for booking and payment to the hotel.

### **MEALS**

For those lodging at PRC, daily breakfast is included in the PRC fee. Those lodging at a hotel will need to make arrangements for breakfast separately. Lunches will be determined by work project, etc. – average cost is \$6/lunch. Dinners will be at local restaurants at an average cost of \$6-10 per meal.

### **CURRENCY**

Some purchases may be made with a credit card (make sure you secure international usage on your card in advance). However, you will also need cash for most dinner costs and incidentals. Please bring small bills that are crisp, with no tears, or markings, \$20 bill denominations and less as most places will not be able to change large denomination bills.

### PASSPORT

Make two copies of your passport picture/information to provide one to SSIB leader and one copy for your safekeeping.

### **CULTURAL GUIDELINES**

Many hours have been spent over the years learning the culture and developing trusting relationships with the amazing people we serve in Belize. We would never want to make anyone we serve feel uncomfortable or as though they are being exploited. We know you would not want this either. As a host group you will be representing the ministry of SSIB, so we ask that you honor our guidelines, especially in the areas of dress and picture-taking as noted below. If you are uncertain, PLEASE don't hesitate to ask us in advance.

### DRESS CODE

We ask that you keep modesty in mind as you pack. For integrity purposes, we ask that no tank tops or spaghetti strap tops, low cut blouses, short skirts or short shorts be worn. When visiting villages, we ask that females do not wear leggings – jeans, capris, mid-length shorts, dresses and longer skirts (at least knee-length) are all fine. When in the more modern communities, leggings are acceptable. For men, jeans and longer shorts are fine.

### **PICTURES**

SSIB

You will see and experience many new, unique and interesting sites, people, etc. and we encourage taking pictures. However, we must be respectful, especially when visiting the remote villages. **Some villagers are offended by picture-taking**, so it is important to **ask first**.

### **ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION**

We ask that you refrain from alcohol consumption while on mission with us at SSIB.

### **MISSION INSURANCE**

### AFTER THE MISSION


If your group would like to take a day or two to decompress, relax, sightsee, snorkel, etc., below are several options. Please note, your group will be responsible for all additional costs associated with 'after the mission' activities.

**TOLEDO CULTURE TOUR** –There are many options for exploring the sights and culture in the heart of Toledo District – exploring a Mayan ruin site; chocolate factory tour; swimming at the waterfalls; cliff diving; spice farm tour. A cultural lunch inside a traditional Mayan thatched home is included. Cost per person is \$25/person plus any entry fees.

**SNORKEL & SWIM WITH THE SHARKS AND/OR RELAX ON THE BEACH** – Relax at the beach and visit the shops in Placencia, a popular tourist resort or snorkel at the Barrier Reef.

### **Release of Liability**

By signing this Liability Waiver Form, I expressly warrant that I am capable of withstanding both the physical and mental demands of Activities. I also expressly ASSUME ALL RISKS of participating in Activities, whether such risks are known or unknown to me at this time. I further release SSIB and its Board of Directors, Co-Founders, leaders, employees, volunteers, and agents, collectively AND individually, from any claim that I may have as a result of injury, illness, financial loss, terrorism, kidnapping, or any and all harm incurred during the course of participation in Activities. This release of liability shall include, without limitation, any claims of negligence or breach of warranty. This release of liability is also intended to cover all claims that members of my family or estate, heirs, representatives, or assigns may have against SSIB and its Board of Directors, Co-Founders, leaders, employees, volunteers, and agents, collectively AND individually. I further agree to indemnify and hold harmless SSIB and its Board of Directors, Co-Founders, leaders, employees, volunteers, and agents of Directors, co-Founders, leaders, employees, volunteers, and agents, collectively AND individually. ### **First Aid and Emergency Medical Treatment**

I recognize that there may be occasions where I may be in need of first aid or emergency medical treatment as a result of an accident, illness, or other health condition or injury.
